

We also want to thank everyone in Bruno who helped us extend a warm welcome to the Ignite campers, as we played host to three week-long Ignite camps this July and August, which brought young men and women of high school age to Bruno from across western Canada.

Our Saturday morning cafe and coffee patio will remain open, each Saturday, through the end of August. Stop up on one of the remaining August weekends between 7:00a.m. and 12:00p.m. for a late summer coffee with us!

As we move toward September, we begin to welcome residents back for our Catholic Gap Year formation program. We will have all of our residents in the dormitories by Friday September 6. Final enrolments are still coming in, but we're expecting close to forty young adults (aged 18-27) for the 2024-2025 St. Therese year.

We also welcome Maximilian, Jack, Jeremiah, Eowyn, Julie, Liz, and Monica to the mission staff as interns, beginning this week (August 19-23). Interns are St. Therese alumni who wish to continue living in this intentional Catholic community for one more year, but who will now do so as members of our staff rather than program participants. Interns learn realworld skills through experience in all areas of the operation, from kitchen staff to front office staff to maintenance staff; custodial staff; media marketing staff; and more. Moving forward, St. Therese alumni will be invited to interview for intern positions each spring and those selected will join the mission staff for 12 month terms.

Our garden will be ready for harvest in September. We'll announce canning workshops soon, when the harvest starts coming in.
