

ST. THERESE NEWS

The St. Therese Institute cherry orchard will be ready to welcome U-pick guests by the last weekend in July! The price is \$20 for a 4 liter bucket - 2 buckets for \$30. Come to the St. Therese front office at 650 Ursuline Avenue to get a U-pick bucket and go out into the orchards (for details, call 306-369-2555).

The St. Therese Institute will set up a window on Saturday mornings of August, this year, from which to serve espresso coffee drinks onto our outdoor patio for guests who visit the cherry orchard. Look for the pop-up cafe signs we will put up each Saturday in August. We invite local artisans to set up tables to sell their wares on those Saturday mornings too - call the St. Therese office at 369-2555 to arrange a Saturday morning table if you are interested. We invite families from across Bruno parish to enjoy Saturdays mornings with us in August at St. Therese. Walk up the orchard trails with the kids and pick some cherries; then drink some coffee on our patio while they run on our lawns; maybe there will be a local artisan selling honey or mustard (or both together). We'll serve coffee throughout the morning hours of the Cherry Sunday festival on August 11th, as well, from our cafe window on the outdoor patio.

The St. Therese Institute is pleased to host the Bruno daycare in our orchards for a cherry-picking day in late July, too. We welcome the kids of our community into the fun of picking fruit right off the trees. Hopefully a few cherries make it into the buckets and come home to parents...but we can't make any promises!

This past month, the St. Therese Institute also benefited from the work of a group of our alumni who came to help with our first chicken butchering day of the 2024 season. They processed 48 meat birds for freezing, and now we're starting on our second flock, this time with a hundred birds. A special thank you to alumnus Zach Nielsen (in consultation with Mathieu Denis) for organizing and...(ahem) executing...the event.

The three youth camps we're hosting in our complex this summer, which are put on by Face2Face ministries of Saskatoon, will continue through the middle of August. Then the young adults will start coming back for the St. Therese Institute 2024 -2025 gap-year program. People across western Canada will remark on how vibrant the Catholic life of the Saskatoon diocese is, and we see that play out in an outsized way here in Bruno. Pray for our continuing ministry to the youth of our land, as we pray for all of you.

Summer Library Outreach Program




The Saskatchewan Science Centre Go! Science Outreach team is coming to the Bruno Wheatland Regional Library!!



The Darkest Dark by Chris Hadfield:


August 8th to 22nd - Bruno Library


